

### 15 Pure beeswax candles, premium quality honeys

Creighton Valley Apiaries is a working honey bee farm in Lumby, BC, in the North Okanagan, where we produce premium quality honeys and 100% pure natural beeswax candles. We have over 300 hives that are used for pollination of blueberries and cranberries in the Fraser Valley, and are then returned to the Okanagan to forage on wild flowers. The honey is extracted after each crop, giving each of our honey varieties a distinct flavour.



### 16 Saltfired Stoneware Functional & Sculptural Pottery



My overwhelming desire to make functional dishes is grounded in the belief that it's important to have handmade items in our lives to help us remain connected to the natural world and to each other. Most of my work is wheel-thrown and altered into square or triangular shapes. Pieces are decorated with impressions from nature or geometric shapes that attempt to enhance the form.

The most enjoyable part of painting for me is the experience of putting paint and brush to canvas. I started by exploring different mediums (pastels, acrylic and watercolour) with a definite foundation in landscape as a subject. Now I work primarily in acrylic with charcoal on canvas and paper. I enjoy taking a subject and playing with composition and creatively interpreting the elements.
