They feature re-invented vintage textile treasures, earth-friendly fibres such as hemp and organic cotton, 'upcycled' materials and sustainable processes. The foundation of my work is created from the joyful connections found between threads and fabrics, style and function, artist and audience;

between the present and the past and the lessons of my grandmothers; between the head, the heart, and the hands.

I create handmade stoneware garden decor taking my inspiration from a wide spectrum of global architecture, including pagodas, cathedrals, and lighthouses. My passion for making large works on the potters' wheel and my fascination with architectural detail, has led me to the production of distinct focal pieces for use in the home and garden where a special feature is required.

Henna art and Jagua art are both ancient traditional art forms that have found a use in modern day fashion and entertainment. Henna (mehendi) originated in Asian/mid eastern culture, Jagua tattoos were used by South American tribes. Henna is made from the leaves of tropical shrub. Jagua is tropical fruit that grows in the Amazon jungles and the fruit pulp is used to make Jagua paste.



Both substances are applied in any design the customer chooses, and leave tattoo like colour lasting for weeks.

**38 The Whimsical Garden: Stone Metal Décor**

I travel by my 47ft sail boat "Chiron" to Vancouver Island's wild and beautiful West Coast beaches. On average I choose one in five hundred stones, leaving the beach as though I had never been there. I then sail to our home mooring in our front yard and unload the treasures to my studio where I cut, drill, polish, and create my art work. This year, responding to the request of my customers, I am creating a line of birds and creatures combining metal and rocks.

**39 Jodene Kilner - Acrylic Paintings on Canvas**

Coat after coat I build up a deep, rich, full bodied finish on each piece with the use of primary colours on canvas in high gloss acrylic paint. This allows the impact of colour and contrast to come alive in my own nostalgic images. My designs are inspired by my love and respect of the natural world and influenced by my belief in living and promoting a healthy sustainable lifestyle.
