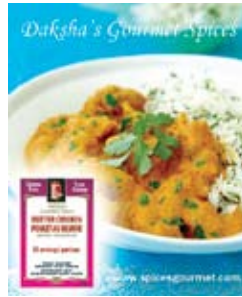
### 76 Rainforest Wood Creations

that create memories that last a lifetime.

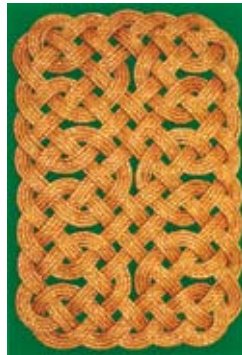
### 82 Leather baby bibs, art cards, accessories
