

Reducing the Festival Footprint

Over the years we have worked diligently to make the Festival as “earth friendly” as possible and to minimize our environmental footprint. We believe most Festival goers care about our impact on the environment and support our efforts to make it a “green” event.

So how can you help? Here are some suggestions for minimizing our footprint, not only in the park, but in the community as well.

Use alternative transportation. Carpooling or park & ride are options for getting to and from the festival in a more environmentally conscious way. Or ride your bike and secure it in our bike lockup.

Bring a refillable water bottle as well as reusable plates, mug and cutlery. Don't leave any garbage behind, take it with you



to recycle at home or dispose of it in our composting and recycling containers. Ask a Volunteer where containers are if you want to recycle and reduce the amount of garbage sent to the regional landfill.

All of our efforts can make a big difference.

We are very mindful of how to reduce our impact and become more environmentally efficient. We rigorously organize the set up and take down of the event to have the minimal impact on the park and wildlife. We clean up all trash to minimize our mark on the property.
